

Acceptance Form and Regulations for Summer Funding

Students receiving Northwestern summer funding must meet the following conditions:

1. Have met the departmental rules for good academic progress during the current academic year;
2. Intend to be registered as full-time graduate student this coming Fall Quarter (unless you are graduating at the end of Summer Quarter);
3. Conduct academic pursuits, and submit a report on activities to the Director of Graduate Studies by the Friday prior to the start of Fall Quarter;
4. Do not hold an outside fellowship that provides summer tuition and stipend;
5. Limit any work for pay either outside of Northwestern University or as an hourly paid research assistant within Northwestern University to a maximum of 120 hours between June 15 and September 15;
6. Not take more than three weeks of "vacation" or non-research time away from campus (it is permissible to be absent from campus to conduct research).
