

How do I declare my minor in Economics???

1. Fill out a Declaration of Minor form and have it signed by any of the Economics advisors. The advisors have the forms in their office. A list of our advisors and their walk-in office hours can be found at: <http://www.economics.northwestern.edu/undergraduate/advising/hours.html>. Be aware that this department does not assign you an advisor, which means you can go to any advisor at any time.
2. After the declaration form is signed by one of our advisors, bring the bottom blue copy to the Economics Undergraduate Office, 2211 Campus Drive, Room 3293 and take the top copy to the Weinberg Undergraduate Studies and Advising Office, 1922 Sheridan Road.
